

Die Cast Operator

Run production equipment in the die cast department to produce high-quality parts

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Mechanical ability to use die cast machines, equipment, tools and gauges, including but not limited to use of auxiliary equipment (robot, ladle, trim press, holding furnaces)
- Able to work with die cast dies, core slides and cylinders with little/no assistance.
- Able to follow instructions, verbal and written, in completion of job duties
- Use good judgment in determining visual defects and variation in castings
- Strive to ensure product meets or exceeds customer quality requirements
- Maintain communications between shift personnel to facilitate smooth/seamless production in order to meet customer delivery requirements
- Able to work with minimal assistance to troubleshoot, determine the nature of operational problems, resolve the problems and communicate the problem and resolution to the appropriate individuals
- Ensure and adhere to safe work practices and procedures. Understand, meet and satisfy all company safety policies and maintain a safe working environment

Skills, Traits and Education:

- High school diploma or equivalent required
- Have good arithmetic skills (i.e. adding, subtracting, multiplying, dividing, use of percentages)
- Have legible handwriting and be precise and conscientious in completing required paperwork
- Be flexible in job assignments and duties
- Available to work overtime if required. This encompasses Saturdays
- Physically able to stand eight hours/day, and to lift and carry weight up to 50 pounds as required to complete job assignments
- Cheerful, can-do attitude. Be pleasant to be around
- Consistently at work, and on time
- Must undergo drug screening, and undergo a reference or background check
