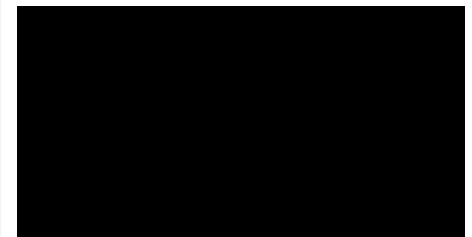

A natural engineer, he developed the automatic record changer, allowing a stack of records to play one after the other. His companies also produced juke boxes and the iconic radio-microphone. War II, he invented a navigation system that allowed pilots to more precisely target their bombs, and was given a commendation for helping win the Battle of Britain.

Miller handed over operation of New Products to his then 28 year old son, Stanley, in order to devote his own energies to plastics and record changers. When Stanley died in 2001, his wife Phyllis--at age 85—and their daughter, Cheryl, took the reins. Cheryl is now the third generation to run the business.

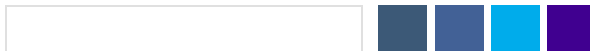
